Participation in the Fall World Cup Short Track Selections is limited to skaters who have qualified as per the SSC High Performance Short Track Committee. Anti-Doping tests may be carried out in accordance with SSC and the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sports.

Entry Details

Entry forms must be filled out by each individual participating in the competition. Entry forms must be submitted to the organizers by **Friday, Sept. 7, 2012 at noon**. The entry fee for the Fall World Cup Short Track Selections is **\$100**.
