## MEMO

March 27, 2020

RE: Bulletin 191 – 2019-2020 Athlete Assistance Program Carding Criteria

Due to the changes to Bulletin 192 and the corresponding MEMO, the High Performance Program consulted Sport Canada regarding Bulletin 191 and the potential impact. Bulletin 191 will remain as currently published and can be found on the SSC website.

Outlined below are the impacts to carding based on the update to the National Program Selection Bulletin 192 (and MEMO):

- Senior International and Senior Card criteria will remain as is. For greater clarity, an athlete must meet the Senior International or Senior Card criteria in order to be eligible for nomination.
- Development Card criteria will remain as is with one exception to the following:
  - A current 2019-2020 athlete who is provisionally added to the 2020-2021 team (as per Bulletin 192 MEMO) will be eligible for nomination for a 4-month card from July to October. After the end of October, carding support will only continue for athletes who have met the criteria outlined in the Bulletin 192 MEMO. Should an athlete fail to meet the criteria outlined in the Bulletin 192 MEMO and as a result, not be confirmed to the 2020-2021 team, carding support will cease at the end of the October and will not continue for the remainder of the 2020-2021 carding cycle.

This memorandum is to be read in conjunction with the published version of Bulletin 191 – 2019-2020 Athlete Assistance Program Carding Criteria.
